The CJSC welcome you to the **New Zealand Jet Sport Nationals**. We would like to take this opportunity to thank our event sponsors and those sponsors who continue to support The Canterbury Jet Sports Club and the Sport of Personal Watercraft Racing.

Enclosed you will find an entry form, tent booking form and general information regarding the event. If you have any additional questions or requirements please contact the CJSC.

All entries must be received by the due dates, Water Cross 9th March 2012 and Closed Course 16th March 2012. This is due to Water Cross event being held at a separate location on Friday 30th March. Should minimum entry numbers not be reached for Water Cross (10 per class) this Event will be cancelled. All closed course racing is to be held at Lake Roto Kohatu, Sawyers Arms Rd Christchurch on Friday 30th March 2012, 12 noon onwards through to Sunday 1st April 2012.

All hired pitt tents must be booked by 9th March 2012 to confirm your allocation. These are on a first in first served basis. A booking form is attached.

We advise you book your accommodation early to avoid disappointment. We recommend staying at the 'Race Course Hotel Motor Lodge', 118 Race Course Rd, Yaldhurst, they have excellent rates and plenty of parking and are 8 minutes drive from the race site. If booking at other motel/hotels please check the availability of off street trailer parking especially for accommodation on Papanui, or Riccarton Rds and Bealey Ave.

Remember to carry your NZJSBA or international race license with you. You will need to present this to a CJSC official at registration.

Lake Roto Kohatu is leased to the CJSC by the Christchurch City Council, and accordingly all competitors must abide by the following regulations

- There will be NO trailer or ski parking at the waters edge. Trailers are to be left in the designated areas.
- Skis will need to be clear of the waters edge and launched and recovered in the designated area before and after each race using a trolley or tote.
- The use of ATVs will be permitted for launching and recovery of competitor craft and for gaining access to the testing area ONLY. Absolutely no recreational riding or racing. A speed limit of 20kph applies for all vehicles operating in the lake reserve. Absolutely no refueling near the testing Lake. Refueling is restricted to the pit area away from the waters edge.
- The grounds are largely unsuitable for erecting tents due to the hard stony surface. We recommend hiring a pitt tent from the CJSC or the use of easy-up style tents as being most appropriate. Telephone CJSC to book a site. Ready erected tent sites are available to lease (\$450.00 for the weekend). Limited number available, first in first served.
- No signage can be erected or displayed on site without the prior consent of the CJSC. This includes signage incorporated on tents and banners. If you have signage on your Pitt gear please contact the CJSC and advise advertising details prior to arriving to the event.
- No leaflets or flyers are to be handed out to competitors and/or spectators without the prior consent of the CJSC.
- Overnight security has been arranged for Friday and Saturday night to ensure the protection of any equipment you may choose to leave at the race venue.
- Av Gas is available to purchase from Garden City Helicopters, 515 Memorial Av, Christchurch Airport. You will need to present your NZJSBA or international race license to purchase the fuel and use approved fuel containers. Opening hours are 8.30 am – 5.00pm.

Registration and Scrutineering

Registration and Scrutineering for Water Cross classes and Friday closed course classes will take place on Thursday 29th March from 4pm – 6pm (venue TBA). Registration and Scrutineering for Sat/Sun closed course classes will take place on Thursday (as above and) at Lake Roto Kohatu on Friday 30th March (9am – 11am). Early morning scrutineering via race directors approval will also take place on Saturday morning at 7.30am at the Tech tent.

We plan to open the track for controlled look laps, these will be confirmed closer to the event. All competitors are required to be on site a minimum 1 hour prior to riders briefing each day that they are racing unless stated by the Race Director.

There will be selected food vendors at Lake Roto Kohatu on Sat/Sun. A wide variety of food and drink will be available to purchase. If you have any selected dietary requirements we recommend you bring your own food with you.
