The second round of the summer tour is to be held at Lake Rotoma, Rotorua, on Saturday, 21st January, 2012, and hosted by the Hawke's Bay Jet Sports Club Inc. We will be aiming for 4 rounds of racing, however please note that this is dependent on your postal entries being received prior to the event so that the time consuming paperwork can be done in advance.

Directions

Once again, due to a weed cordon area around the boat ramp at the Matahi Spit Reserve, we have again been moved further along (nearer to the Boys Brigade camping site where some of you camped last January) away from the ramp.

So on SH30 heading towards Rotoma/Whakatane, turn off at the Matahi Spit Boat Ramp and drive on past the ramp and weed cordon area towards the far end of the Bay.

Please note : It is a Council requirement that the boat ramp **MUST** be used for launching, but there is a distance between ramp and race circuit.

Camping

The Rotorua District Council have a strict **NO CAMPING** policy for the Matahi Spit Reserve.

As per our 2011 Lake Rotoma event, we have once again obtained access to the 8 acre privately owned paddock adjacent to the race site, at a charge of \$2 per person per night. Please note that this is a "paddock only" with no bathroom facilities - "lots of bush". The Club will however have two portaloos available for the campers on the Friday and Saturday nights. Directions will be given on arrival at the lake for those who want to use this facility.

Food on Site

We have been very lucky to secure the services of the **Coffee Chic** from Rotorua who will provide cafe coffees/tea, etc., cold drinks and possibly a small range of chocolate bars, chippies and biscuits. Please remember this is a **cash only** service as there are no eftpos facilities at the lake.

On the Saturday (21st January) the Hawke's Bay Club will have a sausage sizzle available during the day - gold coin donation.

Apart from the above, there will be **NO** other on site catering so if you require other food/refreshments please make your own arrangements.

If numbers permit, the Hawke’s Bay Club WILL be offering the above two classes at Round 2 on the Saturday (21st January).

If only entering one of the above two classes, your entry fee will be **\$50**, instead of the normal \$70. However, if you want to include one or both of these classes alongside your usual summer tour classes, then the extra \$20 additional class fee will apply (over and above the normal \$70 registration fee).

Skis will still require scrutineering and riders must have the required helmet, approved life vest and footwear. If you do not have an NZJSBA Licence, a day licence is necessary (\$25.00 per rider. First time riders - 1st Day Licence free). Please note that both classes are designed to be a fun class aimed at bringing back some of the older skis into the sport.
